Objective: You will create a creative project in English to show your understanding of:

- Present Simple
- Past Simple
- Future Simple
- Third Conditional
- Art vocabulary

Step 1: Choose your project; select ONE option:

- Poster
- Illustrated timeline
- Illustrated book
- Infographic

Step 2: Plan your ideas: Think about your life as an artist (real or imaginary).

Answer these questions:

- A. What kind of artist are you?
- B. What do you like to create?
- C. What did you do in the past?
- D. What will you do in the future?
- E. What would have happened differently in your life?

Step 3: Write your content (IMPORTANT)

Your project **MUST** include:

1. Present Simple (Now): Write 2–3 sentences about your current artistic interests.

Example:

"I like painting portraits. I use bright colors."

2. Past Simple (Before): Write 2–3 sentences about past experiences.

Example:

"I participated in an art contest. I learned new techniques."

3. Future Simple (Future plans): Write 2–3 sentences about your future.

"I will open an art gallery. I will travel around the world."

4. Third Conditional (Reflection), write at least 2 sentences using:

Structure: If + past perfect, would have + past participle

Example:

"If I had practiced more, I would have become a famous artist."

Art Vocabulary: Include at least 10 words related to art:

Example words:

brush, canvas, draw,...

Step 4: Prepare your presentation

- Speak for 2–3 minutes
- Explain your project
- Use the verb tenses clearly

Step 5: Decorate your work and be ready for:

- Speak in English during your presentation
- Be creative and original
- Show pictures and images
