**WALL NEWSPAPER & ORAL PRESENTATION PROJECT**

**Objective:** Create a wall newspaper (periódico mural) and present it from memory (without reading) in English. You must demonstrate your understanding of:

- Comparatives and Superlatives
- Active and Passive Voice
- Present Perfect Continuous

**STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS**

**Step 1:** Understand the Topics: Before starting, make sure you understand:

- How to compare things (comparatives & superlatives)
- The difference between active and passive voice
- How to use present perfect continuous

**Step 2:** Content of Your Wall Newspaper, Your project must include the following sections:

1. Title: Create a creative and attractive title
2. Comparatives & Superlatives

Include:

- Short explanation
- Structure:

Comparative → adjective + \*-er\* / \*more\* + adjective + than\*

Superlative → \*the\* + adjective + -est\* / \*the most\* + adjective\*

- 4 examples

3. Active & Passive Voice

Include:

- Short explanation
- Structure:

Active → Subject + Verb + Object

Passive → Object + \*be\* + past participle

- 4 examples (2 active + 2 passive)\*\*

4. Present Perfect Continuous\*\*

Include:

- Structure:

Subject + have/has been + verb (-ing)\*

- 3 examples

- Add drawings, images, or diagrams
- Include 5–10 keywords\*\*

**Step 3: Design Your Wall Newspaper**

- Use poster paper or cardboard
- Organize information with titles and colors
- Write clearly and neatly
- Use short sentences (NO long paragraphs)

**Avoid:**

- Too much text
- Messy design
- Copying without understanding

**Step 4: Oral Presentation**

- Duration: 3–5 minutes
- Speak in English
- Do NOT read (no notebook, no phone)

**Presentation Structure**

**Introduction**

- "Today I will talk about important grammar structures."

**Body**

Explain:

- Comparatives & superlatives
- Active & passive voice
- Present perfect continuous
- Include examples

**Conclusion**
